<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Turn off all flames/ignition sources2. Close all hazardous material containers3. Close fume hood sashes4. Turn off all electrical equipment	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. STOP, DROP, ROLL *If someone else is on fire, knock them to the ground, and roll them back and forth2. Cover your face with your hands3. Use fire blanket or coat to smother flames <p>NEVER USE FIRE EXTINGUISHER ON SOMEONE!</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Determine if it is a "minor" or "major" spill2. Use spill kit to contain the spill3. Assist anyone who may have been contaminated or injured4. Remove all contaminating clothing5. Wash affected area for atleast 15 minutes
